

## FAQ's for the On-Line Admission Tests

### Registration & Enrolment Related FAQ's –

#### Q1. How to Register for the Home based online admission Test?

- At the admission test website ([www.admissiontest.fiitjee.com](http://www.admissiontest.fiitjee.com)), Go to “**Register Now**” button and **Choose the Test Date**, you wish to appear for the test.
- If you are enrolled in a FIITJEE Classroom / Integrated School / Distance Learning Program or you had registered for a FIITJEE test previously, click “**YES**” button and login with the same user Id / Password as allocated to you for the previous test & then proceed for the payment to get the Hall Ticket & Test details.
- New Students should register by Clicking “**NO**” button & fill all the details like Personal Details, Test Details, School Details etc. and proceed for the payment to get the hall ticket & Test details.

#### Q2. What are the upcoming FIITJEE's Home based online admission test dates?

In view of corona virus pandemic FIITJEE Home based online Admission tests will be held instead of offline tests. Tests will be held as per below mentioned schedule. For more details you can visit the website [www.fiitjee.com](http://www.fiitjee.com).

#### Q3. Can I Attempt a Sample Mock online paper before Registration?

No. Mock online paper will be available to students after registration only. One sample mock FIITJEE Admission Test will be available on <https://fiitjee-admissions.mypat.in> The web-link for the same will be shared with you through an e-mail & SMS. Students registering till 7:00 pm everyday will be able to access mock tests on the very next day 11:00 am onwards and students registering after 7:00 pm will have to wait one extra day to access the mock tests.

#### Q4. Will I be considered for a scholarship through this online admission Test?

1. Online Admission Test Fee is only Rs. 100/-
2. However, those wanting to be considered for scholarships need to pay an additional Rs. 400/- for an offline test i.e. a total of Rs. 500/-. The offline test will be held for the admitted Students in June or July 2020 or based on prevailing conditions as per the government norms and based on the marks scored by the student in this offline test, Scholarship will be decided. Students need to perform above a certain cutoff of marks to be considered for the same.

#### Q5. Whom to contact if I have a difficulty in doing the Registration online or I need a clarification?

#### Q 6. What is the test schedule and test pattern?

Yes. Test duration & pattern will be same for all students of a class. The duration & pattern of test may vary from one class to another.

Note : Students are advised to login 30 minutes prior to the actual test timings. This time can be used for settling down and making sure that they are ready to give their best in the test.		

**Q 7. How and when the result of Home based online admission tests be declared? How many days will be given to join FIITJEE?**

The results will be declared online and will be available on [www.fiiitjee.com](http://www.fiiitjee.com) & [www.admissiontest.fiiitjee.com](http://www.admissiontest.fiiitjee.com). Selected students can join during the enrolment window of their respective tests and start availing online classes immediately. **Q 8. What will be admission procedure? What documents are required at the time of admission? In the current situation how can we deposit fee online?**

Registration for FIITJEE admission test is online. Enrolments will also be online. You will only need to pay (through NEFT) the Admission Fee for FIITJEE Program & Fee for our online partner – myPAT (myPAT Fee is not applicable for students of class VI, VII & VIII). Balance Fee will be payable once we start offline classes soon or if lockdown is prolonged, the details of the fee to be paid will be communicated to the students & their parents. For more details please contact FIITJEE centre, you want to study / enrol.

We also offer direct admission and scholarships to Students on the basis of their performance in various scholastic exams. Please visit <https://www.fiitjee.com/Scholarships> to know the details.

As per their Respective enrollment window, students / Parents are required to visit [www.fiitjee.com/enrollment\\_Lockdown](http://www.fiitjee.com/enrollment_Lockdown) and follow the online steps to complete the online enrollment.

**Q 9. Will FIITJEE provide payment receipt against initial payment?**

FIITJEE will provide an acknowledgement of initial payment. Enrollment report will be generated after the lockdown is over and Full fee including PDC is paid.

**Q 10. We are aware that FIITJEE provides TAB at the time of admission. Do we have entitlement for the same?**

Wherever it is mentioned in the fee plan, Tab fee will be collected once the lockdown is over and Tab will be provided based on availability of stock.

## **Online Test Related FAQ's**

**Q11. What machine (Laptop / Tab / Mobile) is required for online Test.**

Student can attempt the test on below devices:

- (1) Laptop / Desktop using the web browser (Google Chrome is the most preferred) - Visit <https://fiitjee-admissions.mypat.in> and login with registered mobile number or email address provided by you to start
- (2) Android Mobile Device - Download the android app "**FIITJEE Home Based Online Admission Test**" from <https://fiitjee-admissions.mypat.in> Login with registered mobile or email to start.

**Q 12. What should be the specifications of (Desktop / Laptop / Mobile Devices [Phone, Tablet]) for appearing in the online admission test?**

Please ensure that the devices that you are using have the following minimum requirements:

- (1) Desktop/Laptop
  - Chrome browser version 54.0.2 and above
  - Minimum 4GB RAM
- (2) Mobile Devices [Phone, Tablet]
  - Ram: Min 2GB
  - Storage: Minimum 32 GB
  - Android Min Version: KitKat - 4.4
  - Android Max Version: Pie - 9.0
  - iOS devices are not supported

**Q 13 . How to attempt Home based online Admission Test?**

Students can appear in the Online Admission Test using their registered Mobile No / E-Mail-Id on FIITJEE Admission Test website or through Android APP. An OTP will be sent at the registered Mobile No / E-Mail Id using which student can login to the online admission test dashboard.

**Q 14. How and when to login for the Home based Online admission Test?**

Student can login on any of the above mentioned channels (Website or Android App) the next day of registration. Admission Test can be attempted only on the date, as chosen by the student during registration. Though, one sample mock test will always be available for practice which the student can attempt multiple times.

**Q 15. Whom to contact and how if I have a difficulty in writing mock paper or live admission Test ?**

In case of any problem faced by students in writing mock paper or live admission Test they can contact the below mentioned myPAT Support channels between 10 AM to 9 PM\*.

\*The call support will be available for the entire test duration irrespective of their usual timing.

**Q 16. Will you provide performance analysis of my ward as you provide in your offline admission test?**

Yes, performance analysis will be available for online admission tests as well.

**Q 17. What if my child is unable to take the test on the given date due to some technical reason, do I need to register again? Who and how will it be decided? How to report?**

If there is any technical difficulty in attempting the test, you'll not need to register again if that you've collected due evidence of the same by recording a video or taking screenshots of the errors. Call our support at 1800 1210 206 immediately to get the help needed to resolve the problem. Our support team will make the necessary decision after evaluating the case based on set guidelines. Please read the test instructions carefully. Not adhering to it will lead to dismissal of the support case.

**Q 18. If the test stops in between, what do we do?**

If you have not submitted the test by clicking on the submit button and the time is still left in the test, you can always **resume the test** by going to the same website or application from where the test was started. If the test does not resume, call our support at **1800 1210 206** immediately to get the help needed to resolve the problem. Take screenshots or recording of the problem to get quick help.

**Q 19. If the test gets auto submitted, what do we do? Will I get 2nd chance?**

Test will get auto submitted only at the test end time. If it has auto submitted before the end time due to technical reasons, please call our support at 1800 1210 206 immediately to get the help needed to resolve the problem. Please be aware that our application can detect whether the submit button was clicked or the test was auto submitted. If our investigation suggests that the test was auto-submitted before time then we will either allow you to resume the test or allow for a re-attempt.

**Q 20. If the test gets interrupted in between, will there be extra time given to complete the test?**

If the test gets interrupted due to technical reasons, please collect due evidence of the same by recording a video or taking screenshots of the errors and call our support at 1800 1210 206 immediately to get the help needed to resolve the problem. Our support team will make the necessary decision after evaluating the case based on set guidelines.

**Q 21. If I join online admission test late then what happens? Will I get full time or less time?**

Test time will be less as the timer would already have started. Test will be submitted for all at the same time.

**Q 22. Can I join online admission test after 1 hour from the starting time?**

Yes, but you will get 1 hour less time for attempting the test as test will be auto submitted at the defined end time.

**Q 23. In case of a power failure in my locality, will I be in any loss for it or will I get to restart and complete the test later? If yes, will it be same day or next day? or never? If it is never, then do I have to take the test again on another admission test day? If yes, do I have to register again? If no, then whom should I inform?**

Please ensure your devices are in a fully charged state before the test start time. If you need to switch devices in between the test due to unforeseen reasons, please call our support at 1800 1210 206 immediately to get the required help. Please note that the timer of the test continues to run therefore test time will be lost by switching devices.

**Q 24. Is the paper going to be heavy? We have very low bandwidth in our locality.**

The paper works well even at low bandwidth of 512 kbps.

**Q 25. Can I download PDF of the question paper at the end of the test?**

No, you can only view your attempts on the questions after few hours.

**Q 26. Can I see all my responses on a single window before submitting?**

Only the summary of your responses to all the questions will be shown in a single window before you submit the test. During the test, you can view the Questions palette at any time to know exactly how many and which question(s) you have attempted, left, marked for review, attempted & marked for review, and have not visited yet.

**Q 27. Can I change answer options before submitting my test?**

Yes, you can change your answer at any time before submitting the test.

**Q 28. How do I ensure that the answers that I marked get captured or not omitted?**

Once you select an option / answer for a question, you need to press "Save & Next" button. This will save your selected option and move you to the next question. Also note, your question attempt count is always presented on the screen. Re-check question attempt count before submitting. Keep a tally and check that the summary presented before submitting is showing the correct count.

**Q 29. If there is any error in question/data/concept then whom or how do I get it clarified as there will be no invigilator?**

Although papers are made with utmost care, but in case by chance any error is there in any question for which question can't be answered, you can leave the question. We always validate our papers from students' perspective after the test. All students will get marks for any such an error, for which question can't be answered.

**Q 30. Will there be scope for challenging the answer key and Answer options?**

No, we are not giving option to challenge a question in our Online Test. Although papers are made with utmost care, but in case by chance any error is there in any question for which question can't be answered, you can leave the question. We always validate our papers from students' perspective after the test. All students will get marks for any such an error, for which question can't be answered.

**Q 31. Will I get answer key and the copy of my answer responses?**

You can check the correct answer key and the copy of your responses after 3 hours of the test end time on the FIITJEE Admission Test website and android App.

**Q 32. Will there be multiple slots available for the admission test? Will it be conducted in batches or concurrently?**

No, there will not be multiple slot of tests. All students must appear in the common slots provided to them. Please refer to Answer of Q 6 above.

**Q 33. Will there be multiple set of question papers or will it be one question paper for all students of every class?**

Question paper will be different for different classes but same for a particular class. Also, the question paper will not be repeated even for the same class in different slots/days.

### **General FAQ's**

**Q 34. I don't have desktop or laptop computer. Can my child take the test on mobile phone?**

Yes, please refer answer to question 11 & 12 above.

**Q 35. When will the batches at FIITJEE, commence?**

**Q 36. On what basis that the batches would be formed? As another test is scheduled at a later date for scholarships?**

The batches will be formed based on students' performance in the online admission test.

**Q 37. If we do not opt for scholarships at a later date, will the batch of my child change? or will it remain same till reshuffling?**

The batch will remain same till the time of reshuffling test.

**Q 38. If we want to continue for online class only in future even after situation becomes normal, will this service be available?**

Once FIITJEE will start offline classes, students will be automatically part of offline class.
